

Race the JAC Promotion

Terms and Conditions

1. Promotion

1.1 The promotion is called **Race the JAC**.

1.2 The Promoter is **St George Illawarra Dragons**.

1.3 The promotion gives eligible entrants the opportunity to be selected to participate in a halftime race activation at the NRL Round 12 match between the **St George Illawarra Dragons** and the **New Zealand Warriors** at **St George Venues Jubilee Stadium, Kogarah** on **Saturday 23 May**.

1.4 The promotion is conducted by **St George Illawarra Dragons**.

2. Eligibility

2.1 Entry is open to persons aged **18 years and over**.

2.2 Employees directly employed by **St George Illawarra Dragons**, and Directors of St George Illawarra Dragons, are not eligible to enter.

2.3 The Promoter reserves the right to verify the eligibility of any entrant, including proof of age, identity and contact details.

2.4 Entrants must be available to attend the NRL Round 12 match at **St George Venues Jubilee Stadium, Kogarah** on **Saturday 23 May** and participate in the halftime activation.

2.5 Entrants must be physically able and willing to complete a 100-metre running race at halftime.

3. How to Enter

3.1 To enter, eligible entrants must complete the **JAC Motors Halftime Race entry form**.

3.2 Only **one entry per person** is permitted.

3.3 Incomplete, duplicate, incorrect or illegible entries may be deemed invalid at the Promoter's discretion.

3.4 Entries close at **9:00am on Thursday 21 May**. Entries received after this time will not be accepted.

4. Marketing Consent

4.1 By completing the entry form, entrants agree that **JAC Motors** and **St George Illawarra Dragons** may collect and use their contact information for marketing and promotional purposes.

4.2 Entrants may opt out of receiving marketing communications at any time by following the unsubscribe instructions provided in those communications.

4.3 Personal information will be handled in accordance with the relevant privacy policies of **JAC Motors** and **St George Illawarra Dragons**.

5. Winner Selection

5.1 One entrant will be selected at random from all valid entries.

5.2 The selected entrant will be contacted using the details provided on their entry form.

5.3 The selected entrant must confirm that they are available to attend the match and participate in the halftime activation.

5.4 If the selected entrant cannot be contacted, is unavailable, is unable or unwilling to participate, does not meet the eligibility requirements, or cannot attend the match, the Promoter may conduct a redraw.

5.5 Redraws may continue until an eligible entrant is selected and confirmed as available to attend and participate.

6. Prize

6.1 The confirmed winner will receive:

- One double pass to the NRL Round 12 match between **St George Illawarra Dragons** and **New Zealand Warriors** at **St George Venues Jubilee Stadium, Kogarah** on **Saturday 23 May at 5:30pm**; and
- The opportunity to participate in the **Race the JAC Motors Ute** halftime activation.

6.2 The double pass is valid only for the nominated match and is not transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash.

6.3 Travel, accommodation, parking, food, beverages and any other costs associated with attending the match are the responsibility of the winner unless otherwise stated.

7. Halftime Activation

7.1 At halftime of the match, expected to occur at approximately **6:15pm**, the winner will participate in a 100-metre race.

7.2 The winner will race against an animation of a **JAC Motors ute** displayed on the sideline LED advertising screen.

7.3 If the winner completes the 100-metre race before the animated **JAC Motors ute** reaches the finish line, the winner will receive **\$500 cash**, awarded in the form of a **\$500 EFTPOS VISA Gift Card**.

7.4 If the winner does not beat the animated **JAC Motors ute**, no additional cash prize or gift card will be awarded.

7.5 The Promoter's decision regarding the result of the race is final.

7.6 Timing, format, distance, race conditions and activation details may be adjusted by the Promoter, stadium operator, match officials or event staff if required for safety, operational or broadcast reasons.

8. Participant Requirements

8.1 The winner must follow all reasonable directions of the Promoter, event staff, venue staff, security, match officials and activation staff.

8.2 The winner must arrive at the venue by the time advised by the Promoter.

8.3 The winner must wear suitable clothing and footwear to safely participate in the race.

8.4 The Promoter may refuse to allow the winner to participate if, in the Promoter's reasonable opinion, the winner:

- is not fit or able to safely participate;
- is under the influence of alcohol or drugs;
- is wearing unsuitable clothing or footwear;
- fails to follow directions; or
- behaves in a way that may risk the safety of themselves or others.

8.5 If the winner is unable to participate for any reason on the day, the Promoter may cancel their participation or select an alternate participant at its discretion.

9. Risk and Liability

9.1 Participation in the halftime race involves physical activity and carries inherent risks, including the risk of slips, trips, falls, strain or injury.

9.2 By entering and participating, the winner acknowledges and accepts these risks.

9.3 To the fullest extent permitted by law, **St George Illawarra Dragons, JAC Motors, St George Venues**, the venue operator, event partners and associated agencies are not liable for any injury, loss, damage or expense suffered or incurred by the winner arising from or in connection with their participation in the promotion or halftime activation, except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law.

9.4 Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits, excludes or modifies any rights or remedies a person may have under the Australian Consumer Law or other applicable laws.

10. Publicity and Media

10.1 By participating in the promotion and halftime activation, the winner agrees that the Promoter, **JAC Motors** and their associated partners may photograph, film, record and publish the winner's name, image, likeness, voice and participation in the activation for promotional, marketing, social media, media and publicity purposes without further payment or compensation.

10.2 The winner may be required to sign a participation waiver, media consent form or other reasonable documentation before taking part in the halftime activation.

11. General Conditions

11.1 The Promoter reserves the right to amend, suspend, cancel or modify the promotion if circumstances arise that are beyond its reasonable control or if required for operational, safety, security, broadcast or venue reasons.

11.2 The Promoter's decision in relation to all aspects of the promotion is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

11.3 Any entrant who tampers with the entry process, submits false or misleading information, breaches these Terms and Conditions, or acts in a disruptive or inappropriate manner may be disqualified.

11.4 If the match is postponed, cancelled, abandoned or played without crowd attendance, the Promoter may cancel, postpone or modify the promotion at its discretion.

11.5 These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of New South Wales, Australia.
